WALK 2

JUBILEE STONE and WARRENER'S COTTAGE

Start at top of Uncombe Close past No 43. Over style. Either go straight up un-official path or go to the right and go up the official path (B5). The latter is more interesting as you go past the badger set.

At top of field go through gate, up a bit and bear right. Then bear left and go diagonally across the field to the Jubilee Stone. Good place to sit and have your coffee. From the stone, take the "permissive path" to the Warrener's Cottage. A lot of work has been done recently on the site thanks to BET. There is a good information board next to the site. Go back to the Jubilee Stone and carry on down the path. Part way down*, just before the Lead Mining information board, you can turn right over the style and follow the field round. You can then either go down Piggy Lane to the Tythe Barn etc or carry on and go back down path B5 to Uncombe Close.



* At the part way down point, you can carry on down and come out in Church Town. Turn right and go down road, through Churchyard and down path B4 to home.

About two and half miles.
